Did you know?

LCIF has donated over \$6 million to the Carter Center (founded by Jimmy Carter who is also a Lion) to help wipe out river blindness in Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, Guatemala, Mexico and Venezuela. Thanks to their efforts, river blindness has been eliminated from Columbia (verified by the World Health Organization in April). When the program was launched, an estimated 500,000 people in the Americas were at risk of river blindness in the above six countries. As the result of the highly successful campaign, transmission of this once 'neglected' tropical disease has been broken in 96 percent of the region.
